

Access to all

Focused on equal access to education for all students, I wish to work towards improving & promoting our inclusive university environment, "Access for All" is an essential campaign idea for an Education Officer as it focuses on promoting equal access to education for all students, regardless of their socio-economic background.

- Accessibility accommodations Ensure that the university is accessible to students with disabilities by advocating for necessary accommodations such as wheelchair ramps, elevators, and audio-visual aids.
- Digital access Ensure that all students have access to digital learning resources by advocating for the provision of laptops, tablets, and Wi-Fi hotspots for students who cannot afford them.
- Awareness campaigns Create awareness campaigns to educate students on the financial resources available to them and encourage them to apply for financial aid and scholarships.

Practically I will endorse:

- Collaborating with the Liberation Officer in further action
